2 Cor. 4:5: For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.

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#### GOD MAKES THE DIFFERENCE

When a person rejects scriptural doctrine concerning how God saves sinners because it does not agree with how they profess to have been saved then the person proves they are looking to their experience rather than to Christ.

The person who by God's grace is truly looking to Christ, though they may not have previously heard a certain point of doctrine, will submit to it when they hear it preached from God's word. ### GOD'S GIFT

Isaiah 55: 4: Behold, I have given him *for* a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people. 5: Behold, thou shalt call a nation *that* thou knowest not, and nations *that* knew not thee shall run unto thee because of the LORD thy God, and for the Holy One of Israel; for he hath glorified thee. 6: Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

Christ Jesus is the sum and substance of the gospel. God has given his Son and exalted Christ therefore God's promises us that Christ shall save his people from our sins, so God exhorts sinners to come to Christ that we might be saved.

**The Gift**—*Isaiah 55: 4: Behold, I have given him.* If God will receive all the glory for being our Justifier then God must do the justifying himself. If God will receive all glory for being just then God must satisfy eternal justice for his people. If God will receive the glory for reconciling his people unto himself then God must do the reconciling. This is why it was necessary that God give his Son. "To declare I say, HIS righteousness, that HE might be just and the Justifier of him that believeth in Jesus." (Rom 3: 26) Christ finished the work.

**The Purpose**—Isaiah 55: 4:...for a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people. Christ is a witness to God's people who alone reveals God to us. Christ said, "he that hath seen me hath seen the Father;" (Jn 14: 9; Mt 11:27) Also, Christ is the leader of God's people. Christ leads his people in the way we must go in order to be saved. "Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go." (Is 48: 17) Lastly, Christ is the commander of his people. He is the King who commands his subjects. By Christ's power we are made to obey and believe on him. "Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power." (Ps 110:3)

**The Call**—*Isaiah 55: 5: Behold, thou shalt call a nation that thou knowest not, and nations that knew not thee shall run unto thee.* Christ knows each individual sinner he redeemed in all the nations. Our names were written in Christ's book in eternity in divine election. We know him not until he calls us. But when he calls it is effectual therefore we run to him and cannot be moved away—"Behold, thou shalt call…and they shall run unto thee." Therefore, Christ shall lose none!

**The Reason**—Isaiah 55: 5:...because of the LORD thy God, and for the Holy One of Israel; for he hath glorified him. The reason God gave his Son is because God has and shall give all glory to him. All his people shall glory only in him!

**The Exhortation**—Isaiah 55: 6: Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near. Has God given you the Son of God? If so call on him now without delay! "And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life." (1 Jn 5: 11-12)
